To qualify for the St. Francis Parish Steward tuition rate:

1. Children and at least one parent must be registered members of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Community.
2. At least one parent must be baptized Catholic (or) actively participating in the RCIA program.
3. Family must complete the annual Family Stewardship Form:

In addition, families are expected to:

1. Regularly attend weekly Mass.
2. Engage in parish ministry to the best of their ability.*
3. Make regular, identifiable financial contributions to the parish offertory at a level commensurate with their means.**
